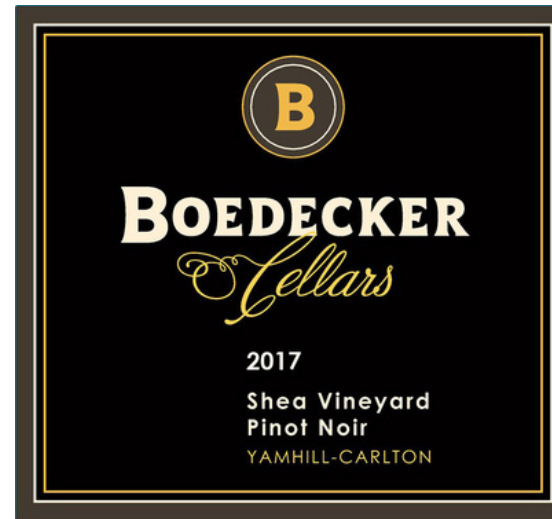

Conveys an appealing blend of power and finesse and finishes with gently gripping tannins and strong, floral-driven persistence."

## The makeup

100% Dijon 115 from Block II. Native primary yeast, naturally occurring malolactic bacteria, minimal effective so2. 5 barrels.
