
"Pungent, spice-tinged aromas of cherry, black raspberry, violet and a hint of licorice. Shows very good depth as well as energy to the sweet cherry cola, dark berry and spicecake flavors, which take on a smoky nuance as the wine opens up. Slowly mounting tannins add grip to a long, focused finish that strongly echoes the cherry and spice notes."

## The makeup

75% Pommard and 25% Dijon 667. 30% Whole cluster, indigenous primary yeast, naturally occurring malolactic bacteria, minimal effective So2. 3 barrels.



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## 92 James Suckling

"Aromas of red cherry, strawberry and hibiscus. Medium-bodied with tight tannins, bright acidity and juicy red berries. Sweet paprika comes through. Slightly floral finish. Tasty stuff."

## The methodology

Organically driven from vineyard to bottle. Sorted by hand in the vineyard and winery, fermented in small open top 1.5ton fermenters, aged 18 months in French oak barrels, sur lie élevage.
